

Banbury Green RV Park & Campground COVID-19 Precautions

During these challenging times, Banbury Green hopes to provide an opportunity for our guests to experience some fresh air and socialization (at a safe distance).

Our team has implemented the following changes to our usual operations to keep our staff and guests safe.

General Information:

- As mandated by the Provincial Health Officer of British Columbia from international destinations (including the USA) must self-isolate for a minimum of 14 days. If you or anyone in your household has travelled outside Canada, you must self-isolate for a minimum of 14 days before being permitted on site. Additionally, please note that the British Columbia Provincial Government has advised against all non-essential travel across provincial borders
- If you or anyone in your household is feeling unwell in any way or displaying flu-like symptoms, you will not be permitted on site. Reminder: COVID-19 symptoms include fever, chills, new or worsening cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, and new muscle aches or headache.
- Please practice physical distancing at all times, maintaining a minimum 6ft distance from other people or households in all areas including the grounds and the beach.
- No day visitors. Visitors are not permitted at any time. Only guests with bookings are currently allowed on the property.
- Gatherings of 6 or more people are not permitted.
- Campfires are limited to one household group per campfire. All campfires must be extinguished before 11pm.
- Children must be supervised at all times to ensure physical distancing.
- WIFI is currently only available outside the office. Please remember to maintain a minimum of 6ft distance from other guests while accessing the WIFI.
- All dogs must remain on a leash at all times, including while on your campsite.
- Frequent hand washing is strongly encouraged. Reminder: Hands should be washed for a minimum of 20 seconds with warm water and soap or an alcohol-based hand sanitizer upon leaving or returning to their sites.
- Office hours: June 1st – 25th and September 8th – 30th: 9:00am – 12:00pm and 2:00pm – 8:00pm.

June 26th – September 7th: 9:00am – 9:00pm

October 1st – 11th – 9:00am – 12:00pm and 4:00pm – 8:00pm

We will not be able to accommodate any walk-ins after 9pm.

Check-In:

- All guests are required to stop at the office to check-in immediately upon arrival. Only one guest will be permitted in the office at a time.
- All transactions will be contactless - please be prepared to pay with Debit, Visa, or Mastercard, as we will not be accepting cash.
- If you have made a reservation and arrive outside of office hours, please call 250.488.2456. If you arrive outside of office hours without a reservation, please call 250.488.2456.

We will not be able to accommodate any walk-ins after 9pm.

Washrooms & Laundry:

- Our washroom and laundry rooms will be open from June 12, 2020. Only one household will be permitted to use the washroom or laundry room at a time. Please respect these restrictions.
- All guests are encouraged to use their RV/Trailer washrooms and showers. There is a septic dump station available behind the office for guests not connected to the septic system.
- All washrooms and laundry rooms will be fully cleaned and disinfected twice daily. Additionally, touchpoints in the washrooms and laundry rooms will be sanitized frequently throughout the day.
- Select washroom fixtures will be closed to ensure 6 ft of distance during use.
- You are required to bring coins for use of the laundry machines – change will not be available at the office.

Ice & Wood:

- Ice is available at the office – card sales or charge to site only. There is a fire-ban in effect from July 21st.

Rental Equipment:

- Fridges, paddle boards & canoes are currently for rent – you must enquire at the office.

We ask that you please respect these guidelines.
